

# Architectural Design 3 - Aslihan Şenel

## Studio Rules:

- Rule 1 Find a place you trust and then try trusting it for a while. [But do not trust anything %100. Also, be boldly and creatively critical. You may make yourselves alternative places.]
- Rule 2 General duties of a student: pull everything out of your studio tutor, pull everything out of your fellow students.
- Rule 3 General duties of a studio tutor: pull everything out of your students.
- Rule 4 Consider everything an experiment.
- Rule 5 Be self disciplined. This means finding someone wise or smart and choosing to follow them. To be disciplined is to follow in a good way. To be self-disciplined is to follow in a better way.
- Rule 6 Nothing is a mistake. There's no win and no fail. There's only make.
- Rule 7 **The only rule is work.** If you work it will lead to something. It's the people who do all of the work all the time who eventually catch on to things.
- Rule 8 Don't try to create and analyze at the same time. They are different processes.
- Rule 9 Be happy whenever you can manage it. Enjoy yourself. It's lighter than you think. [But if you feel down, use it as a driving force to work. Unhappiness is also a productive mood, as you wouldn't expect.]
- Rule 10 We're breaking all of the rules. Even our own rules. How do we do that? By leaving plenty of room for x quantities.
- [Rule 11 Get help, give help, enjoy working together. Bir elin nesi var, iki elin sesi var. Two heads are better than one. Do not think you may know everything. Don't always talk, but learn to listen.]
- Rule 12 Love provides a space of attraction beyond language (of words, drawing, ...), love the work you do, love your colleagues, love the studio in order to start working in the first instance. Choose those ones you love.]

Helpful hints: Always be around. Come or go to everything. Always go to the [studio]. Read anything you can get your hands on. Look at movies carefully, often. Save everything — it might come in handy later.

There should be new rules [those will be written collectively every] next week.
