**THEME:**

Always universal and Contemporary issue of SHELTER is the theme selected for the Architectural Design Studio in this semester.

The aim is to support the design students in experiencing and exploring various kinds of definitions and interpretations of shelter.

The theme offers a wide agenda to do this through variety of **SHELTER FORMS**, embodying **UNIQUE CONCEPTS** in each:

- Permanent vs. Temporary
- On the ground vs. on top of the roof
- At the city center vs. at the periphery
- Self-help built vs. planned
- Utopian vs. ordinary
- Minimal vs. custom-tailored
- In a historical vs. new-development setting
- For the homeless vs. for the elite
- As prototype vs as context-bound
- As local vs. Universal, etc

Students are expected to work on different types and concepts of shelter throughout the semester; and not one long design projects, on selected sites.

From time to time, coordinated workshops will be held with groups of the same semester – those working on the same topic and/or same sites.
